ARE YOU BEING CALLED TO BE A STEPHEN MINISTER?

Maybe this is your chance. We are now taking applications for Zion's next Stephen Ministry training class.

Stephen Ministers meet weekly with a person in need of a Christian listener. We are not "caregivers"...only Christ can do that. We are simply "caregivers"; allowing the Spirit to work through us in a comforting, confidential, one-to-one, Christian-based relationship. In addition, Stephen Ministers also meet twice monthly for confidential peer supervision and continuing education.

New classes will be on Thursday evenings beginning in October. The 50 Hours of Training culminates with Stephen Minister Commissioning on February 26, 2017. Lessons include topics on active listening skills, Christian assertiveness, using spiritual "tools", working through feelings, and issues such as grieving, illness, divorce, etc. No other degrees, certifications or experience is required. The primary prerequisites are a love of Christ, a call to discipleship, and a wish to serve through Zion.

Applications, as well as answers to your questions, will be available at a Stephen Ministry table on Sundays in FLC Room 101 until our application deadline, September 11.

Please continue to pray for Zion's current Stephen Ministry program. Just as importantly, listen closely to God's whisper...are you being called to "love thy neighbor" as a Stephen Minister?

FALL FAITH FORMATION CLASSES

Sunday School for children ages three years (by September 1) through High School Zion's commitment is to encourage both children and adults to explore faith through continual learning. There is still room for you and your children to join us if you weren't here on that Sunday.

We are using curricula this year which emphasize God's word and how it connects to our lives. Ages three years through first grade are learning Bible stories. They will explore creation and continue through the Old Testament and New Testaments with stories about people and events. Second through fifth grades will use the Spark "Activate Faith" Lectionary materials. Each Sunday their lesson is based on the readings used during worship.

On September 4, children in grades 2 through 7 will assemble school kits for Lutheran World Relief with supplies collected by the Women of Zion during August. School kits are shipped throughout the world and this year we are participating in a program to track where our school kits are going.

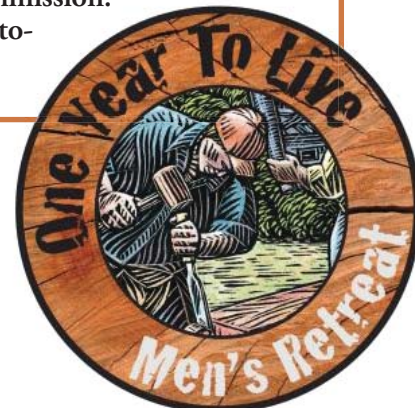
ONE YEAR TO LIVE RETREAT SEPT 30-OCT 2
