ZION CEMETERY BOARD UPDATE

Your Zion Cemetery Board has been hard at work attempting to maximize the usefulness of our cemeteries, especially Cemetery #1, on the west side of Leslie Road across from the main sanctuary. We have discovered that along the back fence line are several sites which are available as burial lots at \$3000 each

In addition, numerous sites are available as cremation-only sites. These plots are smaller in size (4' by 4') and, at \$1,000 each, are less costly than full-size burial sites. Burial lots and cremation only sites in Cemetery #1 are available for purchase, regardless of church membership or religion. The Church Council is aware of these findings and the Council has accepted all of the Cemetery Board's recommendations.
